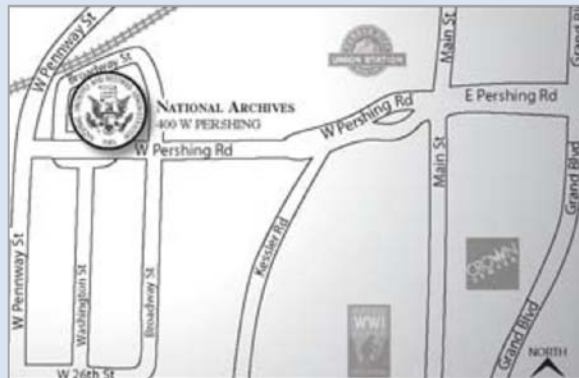

## Directions:

**From I-35N** Take I-35 North to Southwest/Pennway exit (1C).

Turn right (East) on Pennway to Broadway St. Turn right (South) on Broadway St. to Pershing Rd. Turn left (East) on Pershing Rd. At the first stoplight, turn left (North).

**From I-70W, I-670, and I-35S** Take I-70 West to I-670 to the Downtown Loop. Exit to I-35 South. Exit at 20<sup>th</sup> Street. At 20<sup>th</sup>, turn left (East) to Broadway St. Turn right (South) on Broadway St. to Pershing Rd. Turn left (East) on Pershing Rd. At the first stoplight turn left (North).
